**SUPPLEMENTAL EYEWASHES** include bottled eyewash and other devices that do not meet 15-minute drench criteria.

These supplemental solutions are designed to treat nuisance hazards and/or as an initial first aid to injured workers during the path to certified eyewash, but they do not meet the 15 minute drench criteria of the ANSI standard Z358.1. Bottled eyewash is designed to be positioned close to the point of need.

Acceptable for immediate first-aid, bottled eyewashes should support, but not substitute, a primary eyewash or shower unit.
